
Dear colleagues,

The ICPP4 Conference will explore the use of pesticidal plants for global health through the following themes:

- Phytotoxic and Allelopathic Effects of Pesticidal Plants

- Application of Pesticidal Plants in Food and Feed Industries
- Regulation and Commercialization of Pesticidal Plants

PAPER SUBMISSION

- The ICPP4 Scientific Committee welcomes the submission of abstracts (up to 1 page) or full manuscripts (up to 10 pages) on the topic of pesticidal plants and their applications.
- Scientific contributions will be published as conference proceedings. The proceedings will be available electronically on the conference website prior to the event.
- All manuscripts must be submitted in MS Word using the official conference Template.

 Authors are kindly requested to follow the Author Instructions strictly. Both documents are available on the conference website.
- Manuscripts should present original scientific or technical information that does not interfere with or duplicate data published in refereed journals.
- The preferred type of presentation (ORAL or POSTER) and the relevant sub-theme should be indicated during submission.
- All papers must be sent via email to the conference scientific committee no later than 31st May 2026.
- The Scientific Committee will evaluate all submissions and decide on their acceptance as oral or poster presentations based on content, relevance, and scientific quality.
- Manuscripts must be written in clear English (preferably proofread by a native or highly proficient English speaker).
- The presenting author must be a registered participant. Please note that submitting a manuscript does not automatically register the author. Regular registration, including payment of the registration fee, is obligatory for all presenters.

REGISTRATION

Registration is required to attend all scientific sessions and social events of the conference. Please note that only fully registered participants will be admitted to the scientific sessions and that presenting authors must be registered participants.

The regular registration fee will be charged from 15th June till 13th September 2026.

After 13th September 2026, all payments will be charged as the On-site registration fee.
