Activities in 2011 and 2012 Agriculture Faculty Banja Luka

- •FABL role in this project is through collecting and mapping of seed material (vetchlings, faba bean, vetches), ex situ and in situ preservation and characterization of collected accessions.
- •Exchanges of this material between partners will be one of the activities.
- •All this activities were connected with other international project, in which group for fodder crops had active role, as well as, with activities in ECPGR

During 2011 collection expeditions for collecting legume species were done in four regions:

- •Mountains Šiša and Vlašić and
- •Regions Mliništa and Nevesinje



In autumn 2011 field trial with existing and collected accessions is established. Trial was established together with accessions from our partners from Novi Sad.
